In order to reserve your stay, please let us know:

*Each Guest House has been designed for tranquil indoor/outdoor living and offers hot water and comfortable mattresses for peaceful sleep. El Camino del Sol's property is kept under 24 hour security.

Depending on your needs, we have four homes open for guests:

1. **Casa Santa Rosa** http://www.nicayoga.com/Casa_Santa_Rosa.pdf :
Tucked inside a gated yard, Casa Santa Rosa offers a perfect balance of privacy and community with its proximity to El Camino del Sol's Pool, Cafe and Yoga Deck within sight. Three bedrooms each with private baths, full kitchen, and a spacious outdoor living space with dining table, rocking chairs and hammocks nestled under a traditional thatched roof. Other amenities include an outdoor shower, TV/DVD player, mini-bar, kids play toys and laundry facility.

Sleeps up to 9 people:

1st rm:1 Queen, 2nd rm:1 Queen & 1 Twin, 3rd rm:1 Queen & Bunk Beds

**Cost: All rooms \$43 single occupancy, multiple occupancy \$10 per additional person

Weekly rate (7 nights): \$258 single occupancy, \$70 per additional person

Monthly rate \$675 single occupancy, for multiple occupancy \$150 per additional person

Entire House - \$129/night

Air Conditioning – Extra \$10/night/room

2. **Om Studio:** A little further outside the center of the community, Om studio is nestled beside the grazing pastures of the neighboring farm, and is just a brisk walk from El Camino del Sol's pool, cafe and yoga deck. A quaint studio with full kitchen, queen bed and private bathroom; other amenities include TV/DVD player and mini-bar.

Sleeps 2 people with option to add a twin floor mattress to sleep a total of 3.

**Cost: \$48 single occupancy a night, multiple occupancy \$10 per additional person

Weekly rate (7 nights): \$288 single occupancy, \$70 per additional person

Monthly rate \$600 single occupancy, for multiple occupancy \$150 additional person



3. **Casa Rio Grande** http://www.nicayoga.com/Casa_Rio_Grande.pdf : Perched high on an embankment overlooking the rolling hills and expansive countryside, Casa Rio Grande offers the best scenic views of all our guest houses. A two leveled house, the outdoor living space on the second floor provides excellent sunset viewing or star gazing. Three bedrooms each with private bath, a common lounge space and a full kitchen with adjoining dining room; other amenities include mini-bar and laundry facility.
Sleeps up to 6 people, 1 queen bed in each room

****Cost:** All rooms \$38 single occupancy, multiple occupancy \$10 per additional person
Weekly rate (7 nights): \$228 single occupancy, \$70 per additional person
Monthly rate \$675 single occupancy, for multiple occupancy \$150 per additional person

4. **Casa Diosa** http://www.nicayoga.com/Casa_Diosa.pdf : A beautifully landscaped one-bedroom home, Casa Diosa is perfect for a romantic couple's getaway or a single traveler seeking relaxation. Located in the heart of El Camino del Sol's community and overlooking the pool and yoga deck, the main feature of Casa Diosa is its gated flower garden and private patio. One bedroom, one bath and full kitchen, other amenities include AC, laundry facility and mini-bar. Sleeps up to 2 people, 1 queen bed

****Cost:** \$65/\$80 with AC single occupancy, \$10 per additional person
Weekly rate (7 nights) \$390/\$480 with AC single occupancy, \$10 additional person
Monthly rate \$975/\$1200 with AC single occupancy

Once it is decided which Guest house best suites your needs, we will send you an estimated invoice. For convenience, payment for accommodations is broken down into:

- ❖ 20% Reservation Deposit to reserve your dates
Exceptions can be made for last minute reservations/drop in's
- ❖ Remaining 80% of total cost due upon arrival at El Camino del Sol

Once we have received your Reservation Deposit, you will receive a confirmation email and a Pre-Arrival Packet of pertinent information regarding your stay at El Camino.

Getting Here

There are several options for getting to San Juan del Sur, the most popular being via Managua, Nicaragua or from Liberia or San Jose, Costa Rica.

From Costa Rica: After flying into either the San Jose or Liberia airports, we recommend taking the Tica Bus across the boarder to Rivas, Nicaragua (approximately \$21). You may find out more information and book reservations on www.ticabus.com. Please note there is a border crossing fee for admission into Nicaragua; have approximately \$10 US dollars and your passport ready for the crossing (it is most convenient to have USD, as there is a higher rate and longer wait to change Colones).

The Tica Bus will stop in Rivas, Nicaragua, which is about a half hour from El Camino del Sol. From Rivas, you can hail a taxi or take the “colectivo bus” to San Juan del Sur. (You may find this slightly more challenging and expensive at night). You can expect to pay anywhere from \$2 - \$5 dollars during the day, and up to \$20 at night.

Note: You may also arrive by the Tica Bus from any other country in Latin America.

From Managua, Nicaragua: After arriving in Managua, the travel time to El Camino del Sol is about two hours. You can book a shuttle with Iskra Travel Shuttle www.iskratravel.com Taxis also run from Managua to San Juan del Sur, or you can opt to rent at either www.alamonicaragua.com or www.dollar.com.ni

You may want to stay at a hotel if you arrive late. We recommend Hotel Camino Real <http://www.caminoreal.com.ni/> .

Driving Directions from Managua Airport to El Camino de Sol

Exiting the airport, take a right on the main road heading toward the western coastline:

- Go straight through the first roundabout you come to
- Continue straight through the 2nd roundabout
- Veer right when you see an intersection with a sign to Tipitapa; Landmark: Pollo Frit Restaurant
- Pass by Tipitapa
- Continue straight toward Masaya. It will be about 20-25km to Masaya.
- Go straight on 1st roundabout in Masaya.



- Continue straight through 2nd roundabout toward Granada. It will be about 18km to Granada.
- When you enter the city of Granada look for the exit toward Nandaime.
- Turn left toward Nandaime. From Granada to Nandaime it will be 21km.
- Passing through Nandaime, head toward Rivas.
- Continue straight for about 30 minutes until you arrive in Rivas.
- Passing through Rivas, continue on to San Juan del Sur (you're almost here!)
- Drive about 15 minutes, then turn right at "La Virgen". Continue toward San Juan del Sur. El Camino del Sol is on the left directly off the main road at kilometer 137.5.
